

UUFPP Allergy Awareness Policy
Passed by the Policy Board on July 23, 2014

“To celebrate life” is an important part of the UUFPP mission. In support of this, there are many different events where food is served at UUFPP. Knowing that for some events food is prepared on the premises, where there can be tight control and at other events food is brought in by volunteers, where there is less control, the UUFPP will create a culture of allergy awareness. Our goal is to protect members of our UUFPP family and those who visit our church, who have known food allergies and/or environmental allergies. In addition we will address health concerns related to serving food at UUFPP. In affirming that the UUFPP is an Allergy Aware Church, we recognize that there are also many environmental allergies and sensitivities. We also recognize, with the number of groups and types of events, there is a need to be flexible.

In conjunction with this Allergy Awareness Policy there will be an Allergy Awareness Plan that will give guidelines in the following areas:

- Environmental Concerns
- Emergency Plan
- Communications
